

HOW MUCH DOES MY HORSE WEIGH?

Do a calculation...



$$\text{Body Weight (kg)} = \frac{[\text{girth (cm)} \times \text{girth (cm)}] \times \text{length (cm)}}{11,880}$$

Ask your vet: S/he might have scales at the equine hospital and mobile veterinarians often have a 'weighbridge' (scales) incorporated into the floor of the crush. This is probably the best method.

or

Or get a weight measuring tape



or

Use your local weighbridge – weigh the trailer once empty and again with your horse on board (this might require 2 trips depending on your horse)
